Officials intercepted Sharjah bound smuggler, seized 27 lakh in foreign currency

Another smuggler smuggling gold bars was nabbed on airport

His accomplice, an Air India employee has also been arrested



Foreign currency seized from the smuggler at Rajiv Gandhi International Airport in Hyderabad Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) sleuths nabbed three persons involved in smuggling foreign currency and gold bars in the country.

In two separate cases, DRI officials arrested two smugglers on Rajiv Gandhi International Airport in Hyderabad. An airline employee wearing Air India-SATS identity card was also arrested.

Acting on specific intelligence, DRI officials intercepted a passenger who was to board Indigo flight 6E 1405 to Sharjah after clearing immigration and security check.
