DRI Officials seize 1992 gms gold at Vizag Railway Station

Visakhapatnam, Sep 24 (UNI) The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) Officials, intercepted a passenger travelling from Guwahati to Chennai in Train No. 15630 in the early hours here on Monday at Visakhapatnam Railway Station.

According to DRI Release here, the officials found that the passenger was carrying Gold in the form of sheets concealed inside two bags and gold in biscuit form concealed in a musical instrument Guitar.

The weight of the smuggled gold was 1,992 grams. The passenger was entrusted with the job of smuggling the said contraband from Myanmar into the country and carrying the smuggled gold to Chennai to be handed over to certain unknown persons.
