

MP: DRI seizes half kg gold concealed in body at Indore airport

INDORE: Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) Indore Zonal Unit on late Sunday night seized around 500gm gold valued at Rs 20.40 lakh, concealed in paste form in rectal capsules by a passenger at Indore airport in MP.

The DRI officials conducted the operation at Devi Ahilyabai International airport and intercepted a passenger who arrived from Dubai on Air India flight 904. They found recovered approximately half kg gold in paste form two oval capsules from his rectum.

The accused was planning to carry this gold to Mumbai, a release said adding for further investigation DRI handed the case to officers of Air Intelligence Unit (AIU) of Indore Customs.

This is second case by DRI Indore in "Dubai- Indore flight" after 5 kg foreign gold seizure in September 29, 2019.

In Financial Year 2019-20 total seven accused have been arrested with 13.50 Kg foreign gold seized by DRI Indore.
